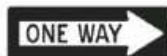

## Gospel Finger-play by Pastor John Randolph

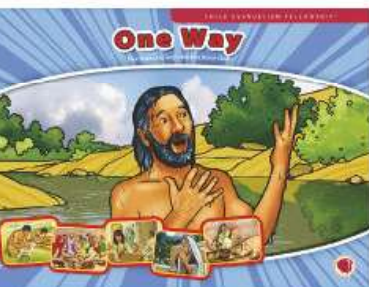

And that's by the Gospel

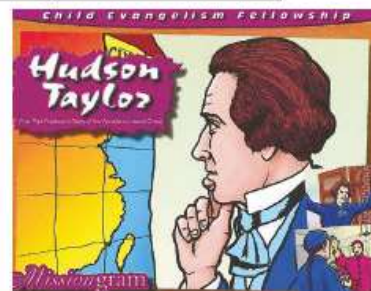
